





YAK SHELF




Cut the back of your Yakoff, right behind the seat.




Place the Yakoff onto a wooden plank.Trace the edges of the




Cut along the traced line to create your Yakshelf base.



Measure out where you want your shelves. Install shelf brackets.




Measure and cut your wood 2x4s to the correct size, insert, and secure them using screws.




TIP #1 Make sure those bad boys are level before ya screw 'em.

Bore a hole at the top of your Yakoff.
This is where the light will go.



Make sure your electrical chord has a direct line to an outlet.



That's it! You've turned your Yakoff into a magnificent looking Yakshelf. That you can put stuff in. Like books or taxidermy.
